

Homeschool Program

This fall we began a new fall program for homeschool students with a curriculum exploring the topic of "artist inspired making". The last classes of this session are taking place this month, and new faces are still welcome to attend!

Arts and Aging

In 2018, The Warehouse started a new program for residents in the Northwoods community, our Arts and Aging program.

The TimeSlips program works to focus on imagination rather than memories to connect with others through creativity, specifically those with dementia and memory issues. Our TimeSlips certified instructor, Johanna Buwalda, makes a visit to an assisted living facility each week and works with the residents. Together, they look at a photo and use their imaginations to envision and write a story to go along with the photo.
