Arts and Aging

In 2018, The Warehouse started a new program for residents in the Northwoods community, our Arts and Aging program.

The TimeSlips program works to focus on imagination rather than memories to connect with others through creativity, including those with dementia and memory issues. Our TimeSlips certified instructor, Johanna Buwalda, makes a visit to an assisted living facility each week and works with the residents. Together, they look at a photo and use their imaginations to envision and write a story to go along with the photo.

An African Tale

The lady has all her little suitcases in the parking lot by the airport. She is all excited because this is the first time she ever got to travel on a plane. It's a sunny day and great weather for flying. She is going to a foreign country and she is not coming back! She is going to Zimbabwe.

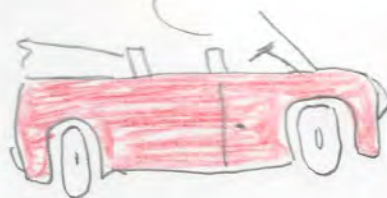
