We often hear Jim's story: "I came for a class but discovered a community." We are proud that our diverse creative opportunities have connected people of all ages, skill levels, and economic situations. Thanks to your generosity, we've more than doubled last year's creative encounters through the Warehouse. (See our real-time community impact tracker at eagleriverart.com.) In this challenging economic environment, hitting our tenth anniversary energized us, as Forbes reports less than 50% of all nonprofits make it to this milestone. Indeed we have had a successful 2022 working hard at grant-writing, diversifying our offerings (programming is up 30%), and improving our facility (thanks to insurance money from 2021 storm damage). As we look ahead, we are working with artists and community members to devise a strategic direction, including measurable goals to ensure we remain an Eagle River treasure for generations.

2022 has been a growth year, but we need your help to reach the next level - financial sustainability. Our goal is to raise \$50,000.00 by December 31, so we may continue to bring access to the arts to everyone who lives and plays in the Northwoods.
